Statement of how the building product is expected to contribute to compliance

B2 Durability - B2.3.1 c)

- Taraflex & Recreation have a durability beyond 5 years, based on NZBC B2/VM1 clause 1.1 In-service history.

Limitations on the use of the building product

- Suitable for interior applications only.
- Not suitable for sloping access routes - wet
- Not suitable for use in exit-ways, sleeping areas and treatment rooms in risk group SI (care and detention) unsprinklered buildings.

Design requirements that would support the appropriate use of the building product

- Taraflex is suitable for sports / recreation applications
- Recreation is suitable for high traffic areas.

Installation requirements

- Install in accordance with Advance Flooring, Design and Installation guide
- Ensure substrate is smooth, dry, clean and free from contaminants. For internal applications ensure substrate does not vary from required level by no more than 4mm measured under a 4m straight edge.
